## Step-by-step guide for users to access e-resources linked to eR Codes

The coded box placed on the top corner of every chapter is called Quick Response (QR) Code. It will help you access e-resources, such as audios, videos, multimedia, texts, etc., related to the themes given in the chapter. The first QR code is to access the complete e-textbook. The subsequent QR codes will help you access the relevant e-resources linked to each chapter. This will help you enhance your learning in a joyful manner. Follow the steps given below and access the e-resources through your smartphone or tablet.


## Install the QR Code Scanner app from Play Store

Open the app to view the QR code scanning window

For accessing the e-resources on a computer or laptop follow the steps stated below. 1. Open the web browser Firefox (3), Chrome ( ) , etc.
2. Go to the ePathshala website (http://ePathshala.nic.in)
3. Click on the menu 'access e-resources'
