

## Forum

The forum allows the user to exchange ideas by posting or replying to a forum post. All registered participants can also take part in the Forum Activities. On NISHTHA portal, forum can be found inside every module of course material as well as by clicking on Forum in the navigation.

Step 1- Log into the account and navigate to the forum as shown below:


## Reply in a forum post
