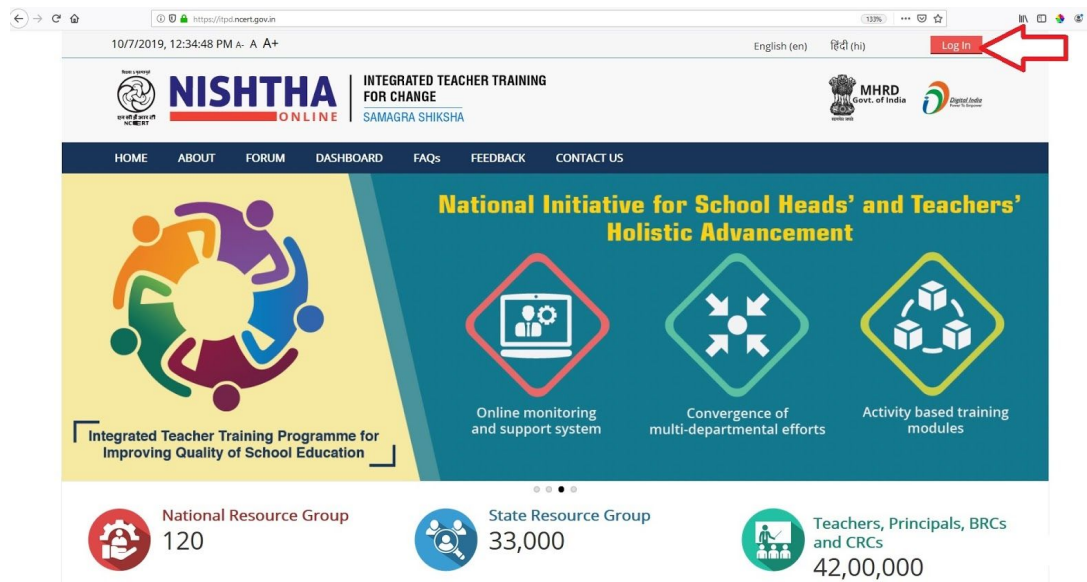
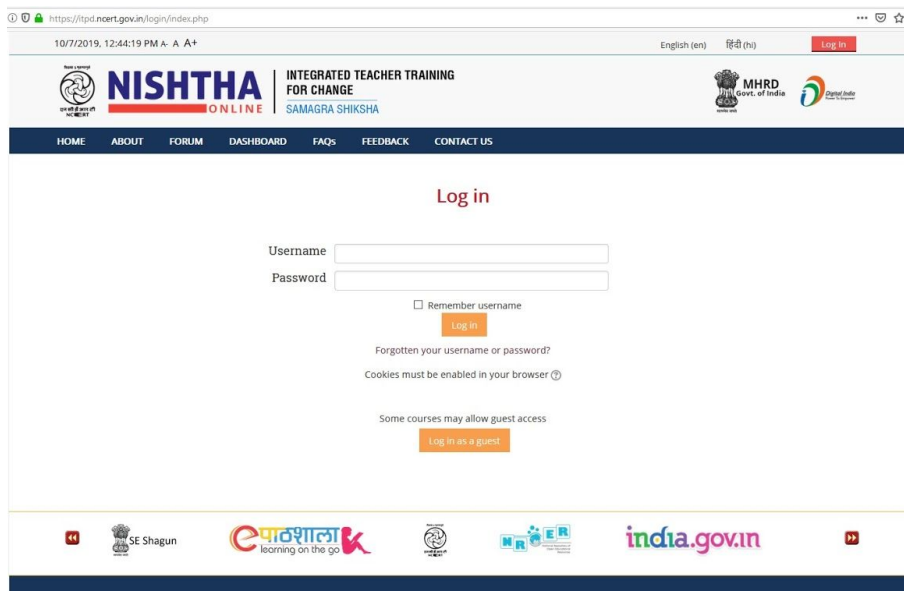


How to take Post Test

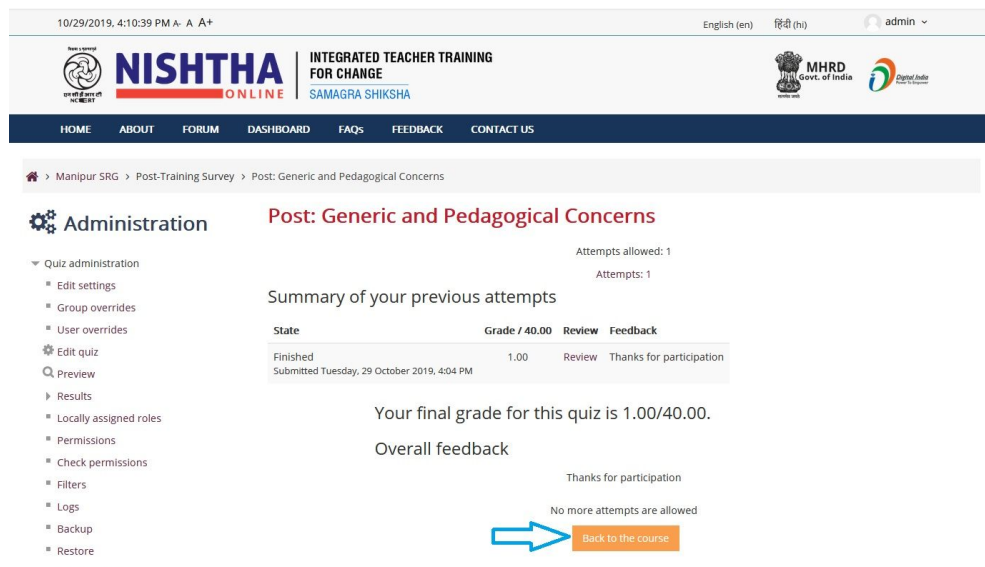
