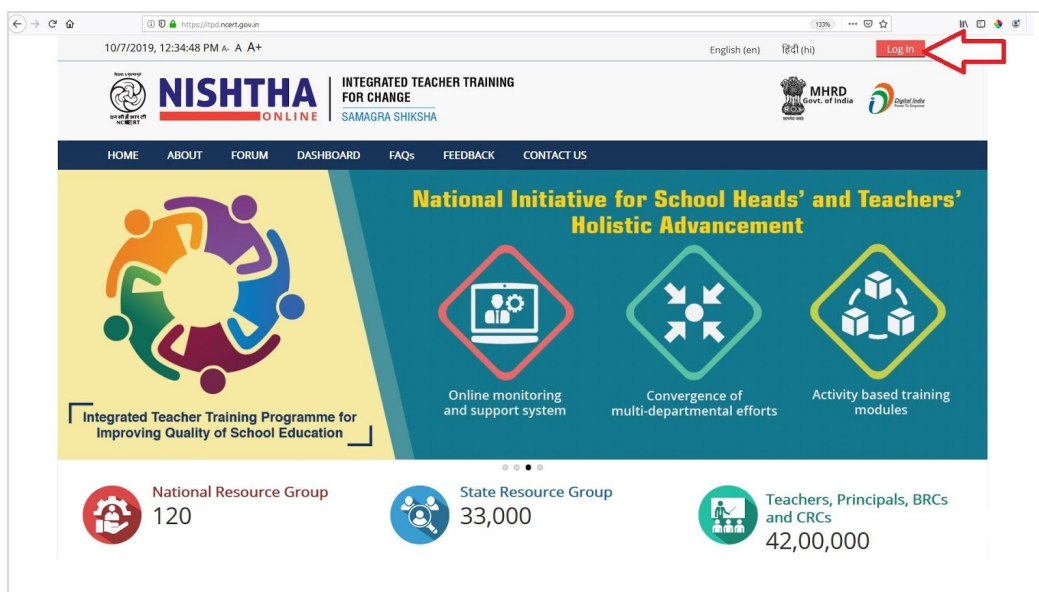
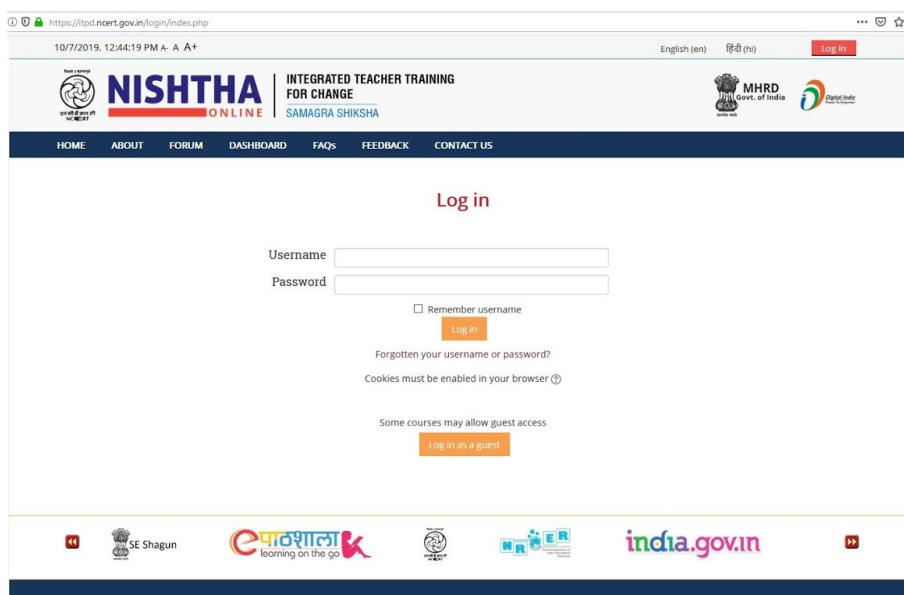


How to Submit Portfolio

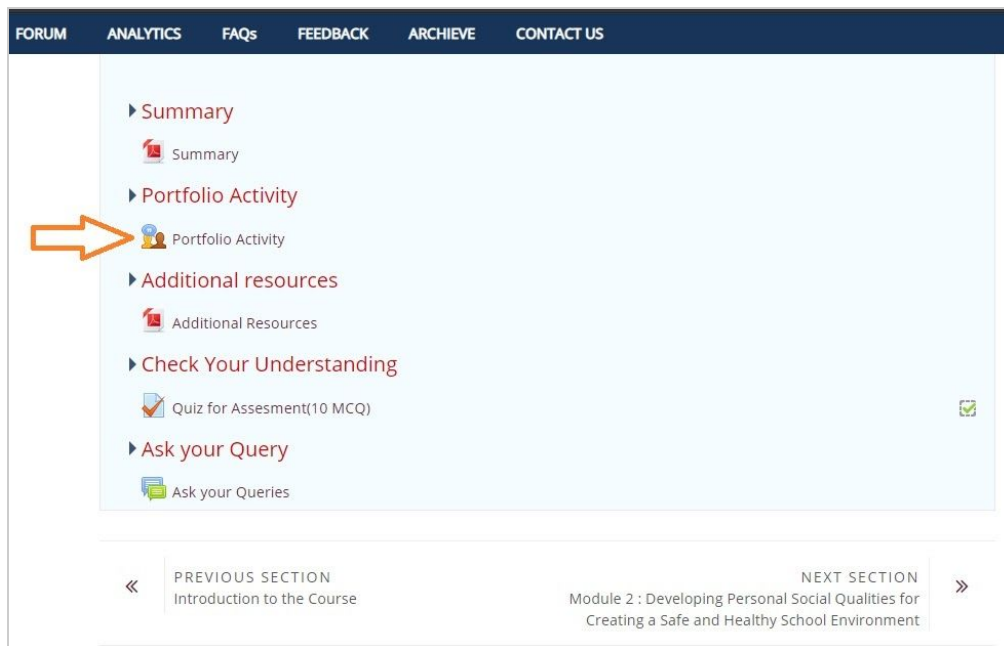

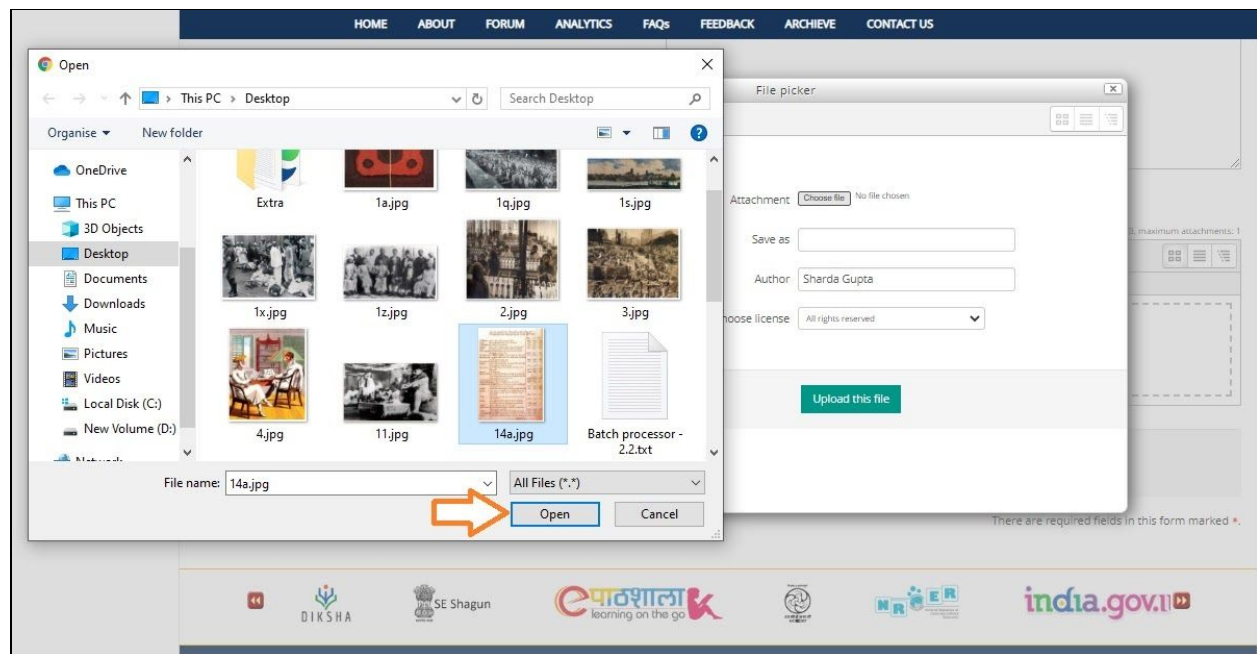

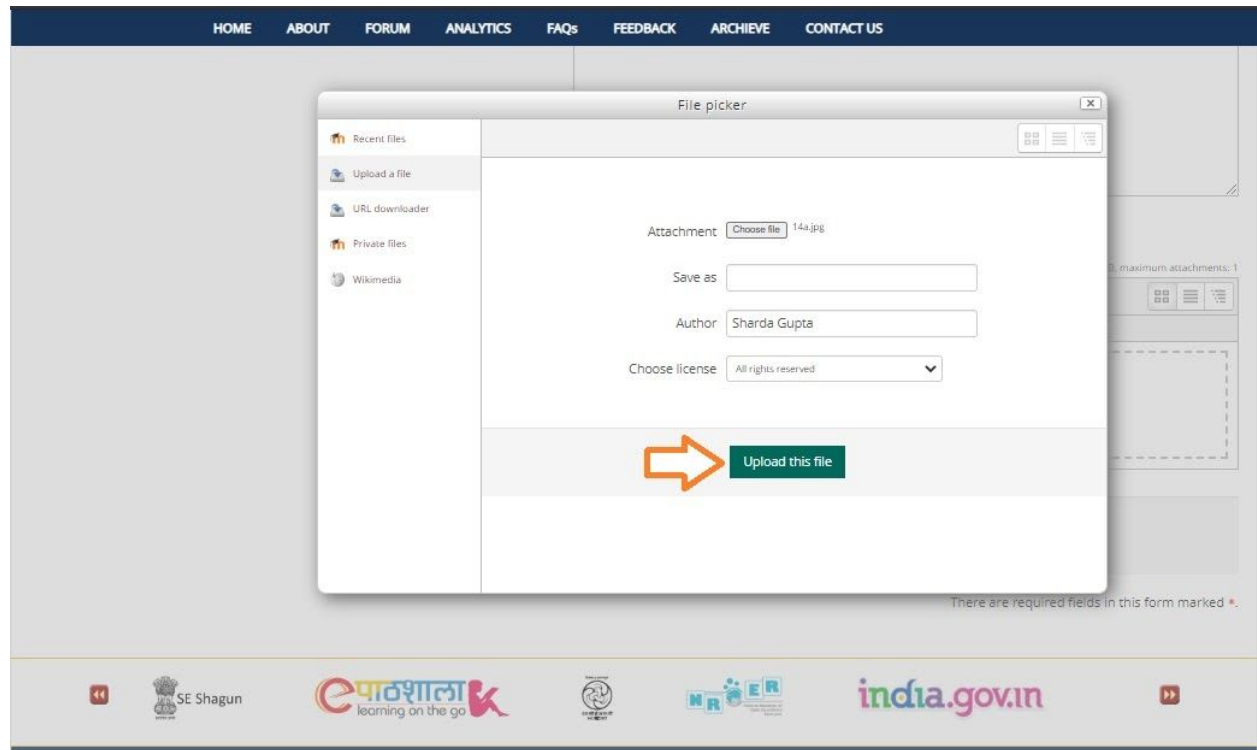




