NISHTHA 2.0 (Secondary Level) Monthly Course Completion Report

1. Introduction

To extend NISHTHA programme to teachers and school heads at Secondary level of education, NISHTHA Secondary was launched by the Hon'ble PM of India on 29.07.2021. This programme will be conducted from August, 2021 to January, 2022. Approximately 10,400 Teaching Staff of NVS that includes all the Principals, Vice Principals, PGTs as well as TGTs in all subjects including Creative Teachers will complete all the courses within the time line.

2. Schedule

Start Date - 06.08.2021

End Date - 31.08.2021

Last Date for Enrolment – 25.08.2021

3. Modality

A formal notification was issued to all the stakeholders' viz. officers of NVS, Principals, Vice-Principals & Teachers of NVS regarding the launch of NISHTHA Secondary programme for School Heads & Teachers at Secondary level of Education.

To ensure timely completion of all courses as per schedule, Monitoring the Progress, Providing Guidance & Technical Assistance, Submitting the Progress Report etc, the structure of Coordinators at different levels is given below:



6. Best Practices

Monitoring of the progress at different levels viz. JNV/Cluster/Regional Office/ HQ level.

Since, the Reports generated from DIKSHA doesn't give the option to filter data on the basis of Organization Name, therefore, the Collection of Courses Completion Reports is done from the JNVs through JNV level Coordinators & Consolidation at Cluster & RO level.

7. Key Learnings

NISHTHA Online courses have developed a better look around of the key areas of the NEP-2020.

Many teachers have also completed the Courses in NISHTHA Elementary, so these courses are working like a refresher course for them.

Participants have become more involved & serious as scoring 70% or more in the courses assessment is the criteria for receiving the Certificates.

8. Suggestions

A provision should be made available to filter the Course Progress exhaust Report. Course Progress Synchronization & Certificate issuance should be done without major delay. Participants have suggested for the option of displaying the correct answer of the assessment questions after the assessment.

9. Conclusion

Approximately 90% of the registered participants were able to complete the Courses. On an average 72% of the registered participants were able to score 70% or above and get Certificate of Completion for the courses.

Although the target to be achieved is 100%.
