



## National Initiative for School Heads' and Teachers' Holistic Advancement

NISHTHA (National Initiative for School Heads' and Teachers' Holistic Advancement) is a capacity building programme for "Improving Quality of School Education through Integrated Teacher Training". NISHTHA aims to build competencies among all the teachers and school principals at the elementary stage (Classes I-VIII). The functionaries (at the state, district, block, cluster level) shall be trained in an integrated manner on learning outcomes, school based assessment, learner–centred pedagogy, new initiatives in education, addressing diverse needs of children through multiple pedagogies, etc. This will be organized by constituting National Resource Groups (NRGs) and State Resource Groups (SRGs) at the National and the State level who will be training 4.2 million teachers subsequently. NISHTHA is perhaps World's largest initiative. To support this mega programme robust web portal and Mobile App for content delivery, training management and monitoring. The NISHTHA programme was launched by the MHRD-GOI on 21 August, 2019. The first cycle of the Integrated Training was organised from 21 - 26 August, 2019. In all 137 participants (117 KRPs and 20 SRPLs) attended this programme.






Cycle 1: Training Coverage (100%)
